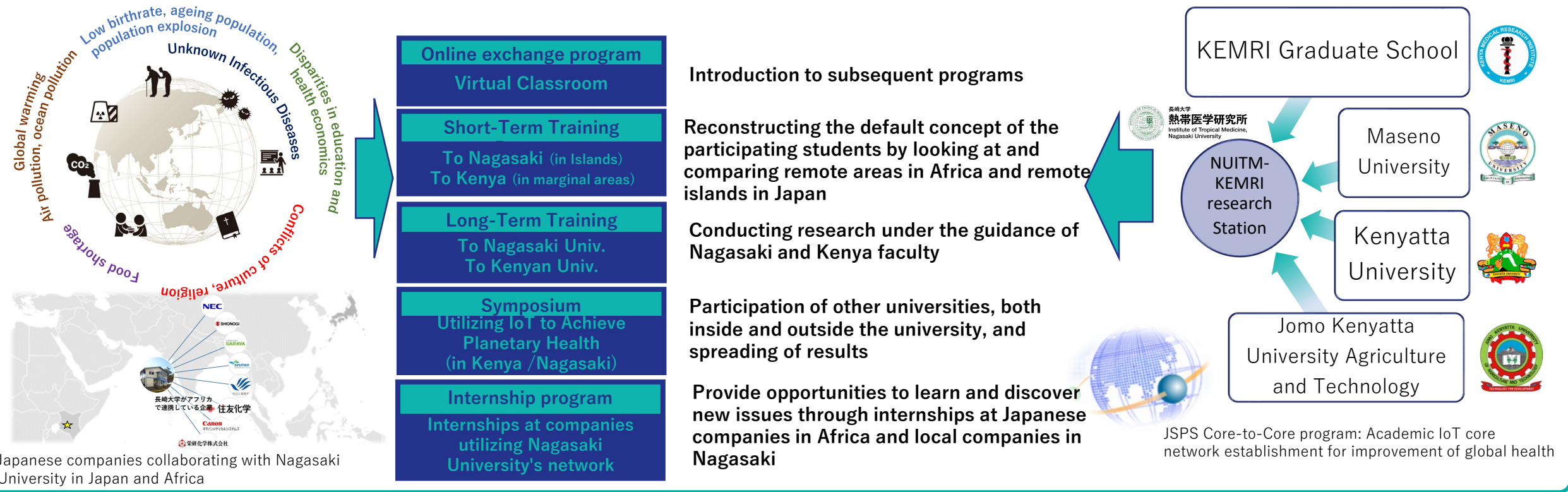

Goal:

To establish a strategic inter-university network with Africa on planetary health and develop human resources to serve as a bridge between Japan and Africa and develop collaborative activities to solve global issues from a leadership position.

Input:

1. Programs on planetary health topics in Nagasaki and Kenya, where students of the same age from different backgrounds
2. Programs to learn different cultures and languages interactively each other



Achievement of goals:

Output: To develop human resources who can lead the solution of planetary health issues.
Target: A total of 95 students (47 dispatched and 48 accepted) from Japan and Asia will be exchanged.

Outcome: "Achieving planetary Health"

Goal: To establish a cycle in which the fostered human resources will collaborate with other Kenyan universities and research institutions in an interdisciplinary manner to stimulate education and research activities aimed at solving global issues, develop leading activities, and develop human resources for the next generation.
